To manage those behaviours whilst preserving stamina and sanity, all boarding staff need practical tools grounded in robust research.

In this fast-paced course, participants will learn new approaches to nurturing relationships, maintaining equanimity, creating durable change and responding to novel challenges. Equipped with these tools, you'll discover much more to love about your job.
